→ because PWUD learn about and practice safer injection behaviors that reduce infection risk and damage to veins

INCREASE OVERDOSE PREVENTION & REVERSAL







→ because PWUD have improved access to overdose prevention and reversal information and medication (e.g. naloxone)

→ because PWUD are connected to and benefit from comprehensive prevention, treatment, and support services
