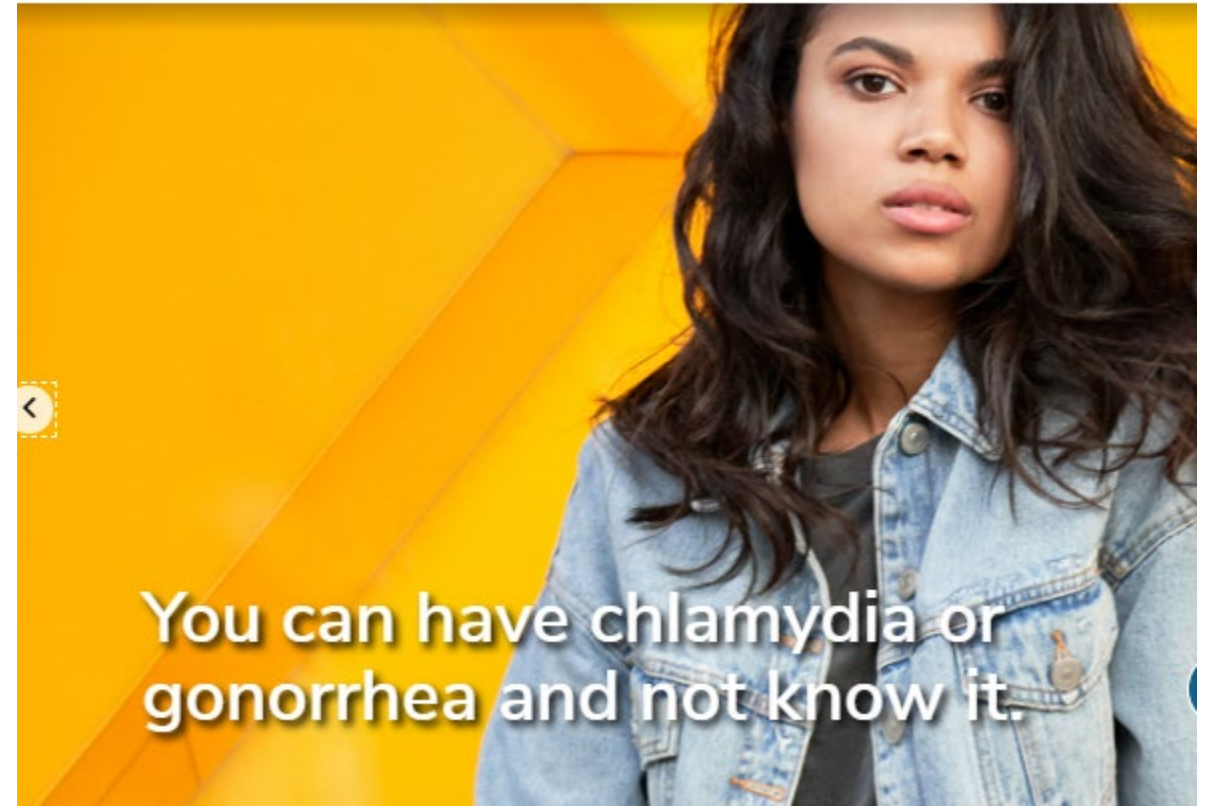

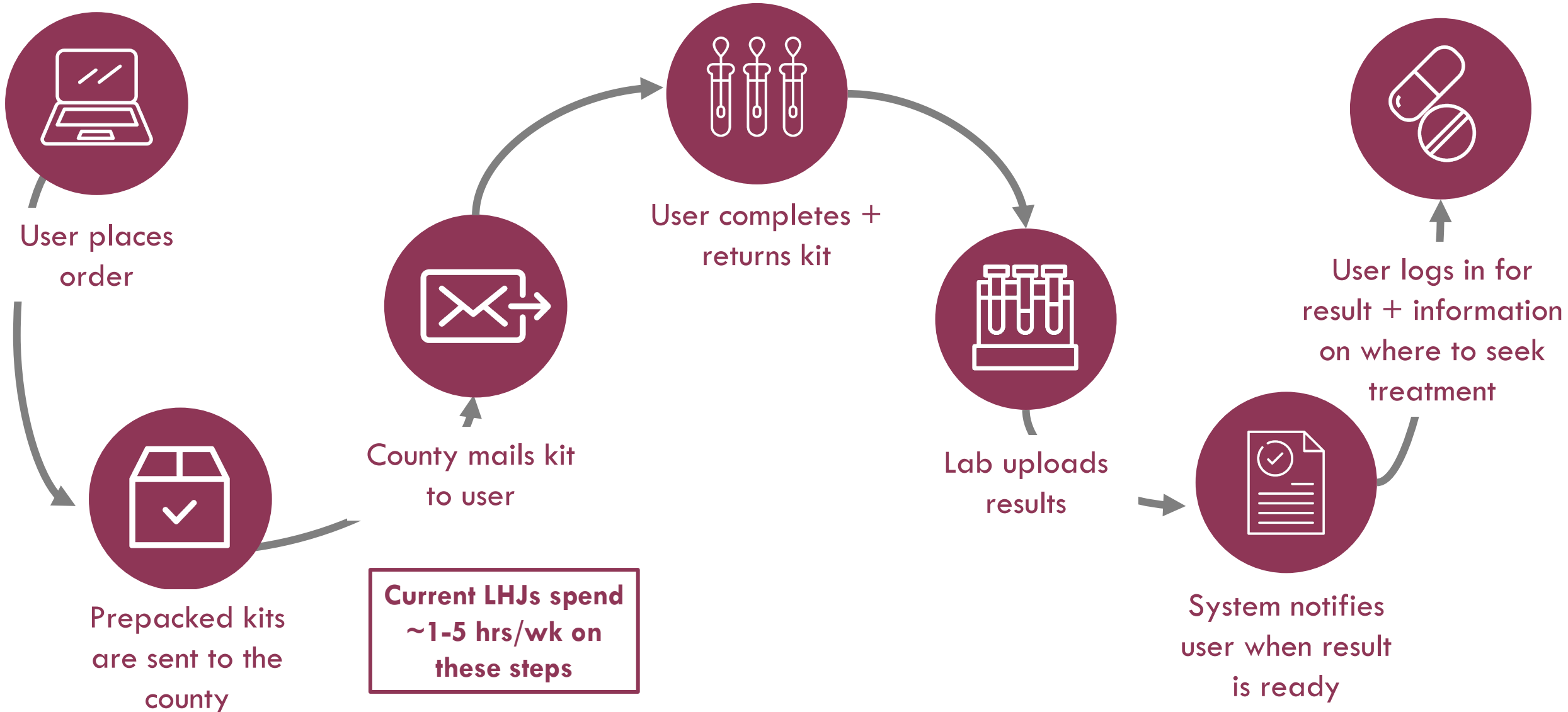
How Does It Work?

How does it work?



Don't Think, Know Features

- Locally designed + driven
- Full access to user + kit data
- Can utilize local/commercial laboratory
- No lab fees for non-returned kits
- Additional options available:
 - Client-pay option
 - Can be added to any existing county campaign
 - Clients can be enrolled + kits handed out during field visits, outreach events, or in other non-clinical settings
 - Additional tests

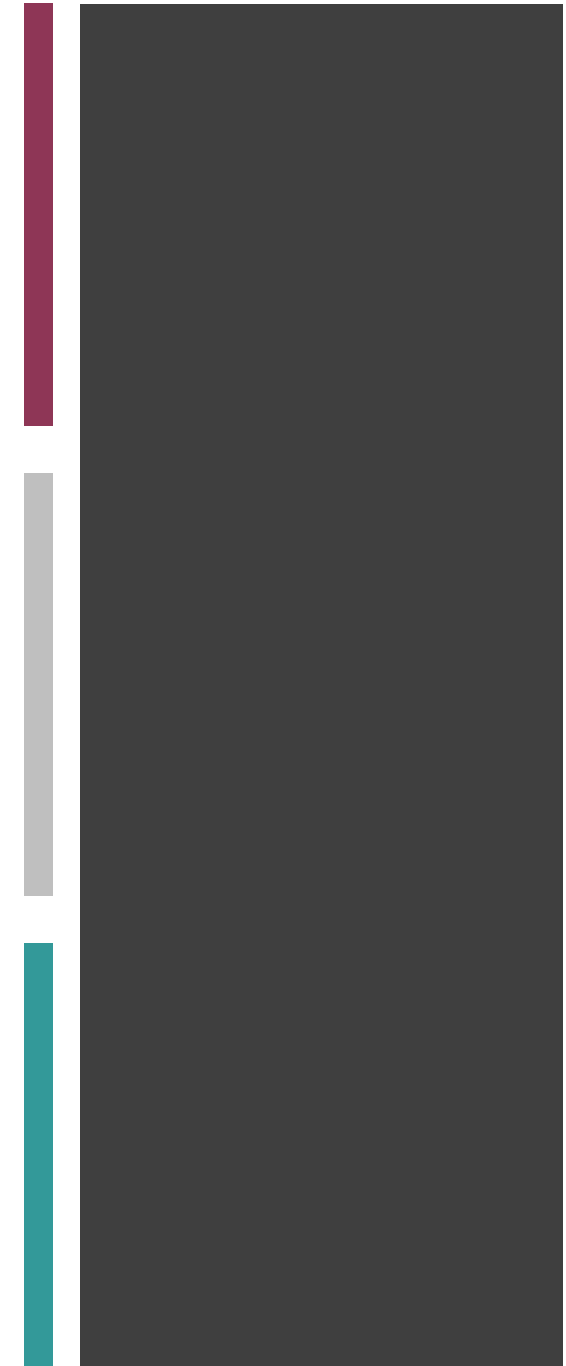
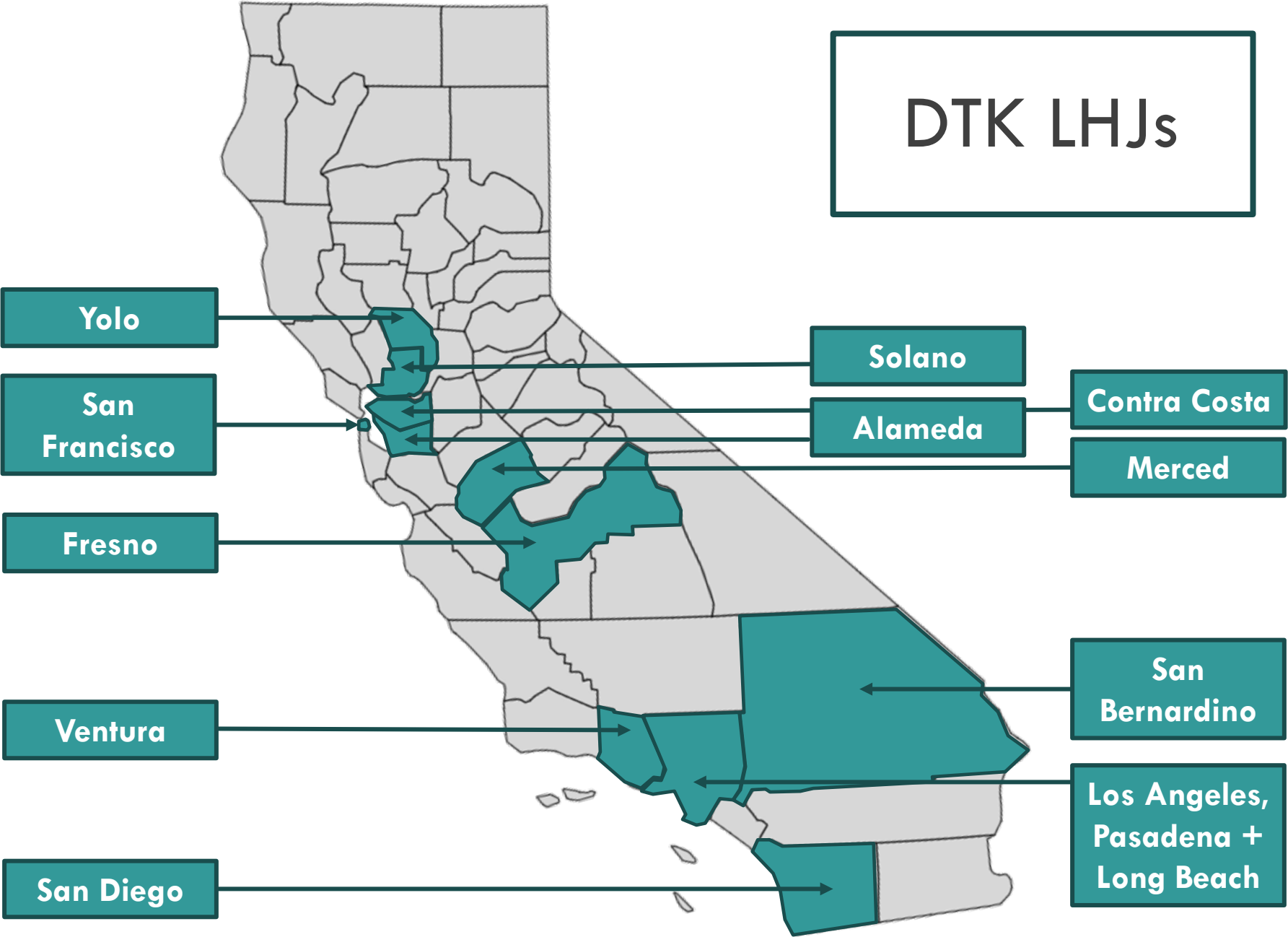

Additional Considerations:

- Lab validation required to expand testing options beyond single site CT/GC vaginal swabs
- Upfront + annual website costs
- Requires some local FTE
